**14. Other Matters Brought to Councillors' Attention**

R Lloyd requested permission to cutback some branches of trees that are overhanging the church path. Council agreed.  
Requested D.C.C. remove all road signs after they have finished their maintenance work. Since leaving them behind is a waste of money and a nuisance.
