

# CYNGOR CYMEITHAS - LLANARMON YN IAL - COMMUNITY COUNCIL

## Language Policy

**Adopted June 2023 Reviewed May 2024**

Llanarmon yn Ial Community Council respects and complies with the Welsh Language Act 1993. Although there are no specific regulations covering Community Councils, the Council treats the Welsh language reasonably and proportionately in its dealings with the public.

Whilst Denbighshire is predominately bilingual, Llanarmon yn Ial has a smaller percentage of Welsh speakers compared to the regional average and as such meetings are conducted in English.

Minutes of meetings are produced and published in English and can be translated into Welsh if requested. The timing of any translation is subject to the lead time of the first available translator.

All other documents produced by the Council are in English.

Any signage and information boards placed on land or property owned by Llanarmon yn Ial Community Council are presented in both Welsh and English language.
