## **Accessibility Statement for Website**

Adopted September 2020 Reaffirmed May 2025

This website is run by Llanarmon yn Ial Community Council and we want as many people as possible to be able to use it. This means we have made the website text as simple as possible to understand and you should be able to:

- zoom in up to 300% without the text spilling off the screen
- navigate most of the website using just a keyboard
- navigate most of the website using speech recognition software
- listen to most of the website using a screen reader (including the most recent versions of JAWS, NVDA and Voice-over) AbilityNet has advice on making your device easier to use if you have a disability.

### **How accessible is this website**

We know some content uploaded to this website may not be fully accessible:

- most older PDF documents are not fully accessible to screen reader software
- live video streams do not have captions
- there is a limit to how far you can magnify the maps on our pages, which are provided by a third party (Google)

### **Technical information about this website's Accessibility**

Llanarmon yn Ial Community Council is committed to making its website accessible, in accordance with the Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) (No. 2) Accessibility Regulations 2018.

This website framework is compliant with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines version 2.1 AA standard.

Some content is only partially compliant, due to the non-compliances listed below.

### **Non accessible content**

Some pages may contain attachments which are not currently compliant, such as:

- Older PDF files such as Minutes of Meetings, Agendas and Financial Data published before 1st April 2020.
- Videos.
- Content produced by third parties or by the Council using third party software.

Non-compliance with the accessibility regulations

We will do all we can to identify content that is non-compliant.

### **Disproportionate burden**

We are a small Community Council and have identified areas that we believe constitute a disproportionate burden. For example: translating documents into the Welsh language, converting documents prior to April 2020 to Accessible documents, providing a text relay service for people who are D/deaf, hearing impaired or have a speech impediment.

### **Content that is not within the scope of the accessibility regulations**

Not all documents on this website are created by us. Some documents and content may be created by third parties or using third party software. Where this is the case we will endeavour, on request, to obtain an accessible copy from the original source or to convey the information contained in the document in an accessible way.

Many of our older PDFs and Word documents do not meet accessibility standards – for example, they may not be structured so they are accessible to a screen reader. This does not meet WCAG 2.1 success criterion 4.1.2 (name, role value).

The accessibility regulations do not require us to fix PDFs or other documents published before 23 September 2018 if they're not essential to providing our services.

Any new PDFs or Word documents created by us will meet accessibility standards

### **How we tested this website**

This website was tested in May 2025. Tests were carried out by both internal systems and our website provider, Yew barrow.

We tested a sample of pages from our main website platform – llanarmoncommunitycouncil.org

What we are doing to improve accessibility

We will provide staff training to ensure that all new content added meets accessibility criteria.

We run quarterly reports to identify and address accessibility issues.
