A cottage style garden created within the immediate surroundings of a converted Georgian house, making good use of the existing wall layout to form 'rooms' with a small lime avenue, herbaceous borders, a large terrace and oval lawns. The 250 year old one acre walled kitchen-garden has nursery beds, greenhouse, orchard, wildflower area, long herbaceous borders. Rhododendrons, in a planted woodland garden.
